Our actions affect the waters around us each and every day because all the water from our property that enters storm drains ends up in our rivers, lakes and streams.

Here are tips on how to keep our storm drains and community clean:



- Wash vehicles at the carwash, not on a street or driveway.
- Use fertilizer sparingly
- Set sprinklers to water lawn and garden areas only, not pavement to prevent loss and erosion.





- Pick up pet waste and dispose of properly.
- Keep trash out of storm drains, if you see it, pick it up.





- Dispose of yard debris and grass properly. Sweep into piles for collection. Do not hose them down the drain.
- Direct downspouts and rain gutters away from paved surfaces.



 Recycle Motor Oil, antifreeze and other fluids.
